

ICCR General Scholarship Scheme. 2022-23

The Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), New Delhi invites applications for grant of 2 (two) scholarships to students from Czech Republic to pursue higher studies at Under Graduate, Post Graduate and PhD level in Indian educational institutes/universities for the Academic Year 2022-23. The courses include science, humanities, commerce and engineering. They do not include medical, para-medical, fashion and law.

Students from Czech Republic having scored minimum 60 percent marks or GPA 3 out of GPA 5 in qualifying examinations are welcome to apply for the ICCR scholarships.

Detailed guidelines, on the process of applying for ICCR Scholarships on the A2A Portal and the procedure/norms to facilitate the aspiring students, can be assessed at : http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/. This portal also consists names and details of all state and central universities and institutes, and colleges, affiliated with them.

The interested students are required to create an account at http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/ before applying online. While applying, students may note following points:

The applicants should be of minimum 18 years and maximum 30 years age at the time of admission.

Applicants have option to apply to 5 universities/institutes in the order of their preference.

Interested students are advised to visit university/institute website and do thorough research of courses offered, eligibility criteria and general information before applying for admission. The students should ensure that they are eligible for the course and are in possession of relevant documents as required for the particular course. There may be a scenario when students do not get admission in their preferred University/Institutes due to limited number of seats on offer. Students should therefore be prepared to receive admission from any of their five preferences.

The mark sheets of levels 10 and 10+2 of school and other relevant documents required by the university should be uploaded along with the transcripts in English.

As the courses are conducted in English, students are requested to submit their TOEFL/IELTS standardized test scores. An essay in English may also be conducted.
